The award will be presented at the 144th Annual Meeting of the American Fisheries Society, to be held August 17-21, 2014 in Québec City, Canada.

Nominations require the candidate's name and contact information (including phone number and email address), a biographical sketch, and an explanation of why they are deserving of the award. The entire application should not exceed 3 pages. We also ask that you provide tangible evidence of the accomplishment(s) on which the nomination is based, preferably in electronic format. It is important to demonstrate that the individual has effectively communicated the value of fisheries issues/research to the general public or, alternatively, has taught or inspired others to effectively communicate with the public.
