Description: The successful candidate will assist Fisheries Biologists with field activities and office work pertaining to fisheries management of the aquatic resources of the middle and upper Delaware River basin. Primary duties will involve sampling fish populations using a variety of active and passive sampling at lotic and lentic waters throughout Fisheries Management Area 5 with focus on American Shad, Black Bass, Channel Catfish, and wild trout assessments. More specifically, the FBA will assist, as needed, with PFBC's joint initiative with NYDEC-Fisheries in collecting angler use and harvest data, angler opinions, and angler counts (mode: kayak) from those utilizing the upper Delaware River Basin wild trout tailwater fishery. Other duties encompass assisting Fisheries Biologists conduct fisheries surveys, water quality analyses, habitat assessments, fisheries data management and formatting, and routine equipment maintenance, among other assigned duties to support the Fisheries Management Division. The duration of the position is not to exceed 375 hours (20 weeks based on a 37.5-hour work week) and will extend approximately 13 May through 27 September 2019.
