The Pennsylvania Fish & Boat Commission is seeking to fill a seasonal, non-permanent wage Fish Culturist 1 position with the Benner Spring State Fish Hatchery in Centre County. This position works full-time 40 hours each week from approximately September 2019 to December 2019. DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

Assist in the propagation, care, and stocking of fish species in numbers sufficient to meet fisheries management goals toward enhancement of fishing opportunities for the general public. Assist in maintaining facilities in an endeavor to maximize efficiency of propagation, care, stocking and effluent management.

Perform various duties necessary for the operation and maintenance of a fish culture station. Technical assignments include spawning fish, care of fish and eggs, dispensing feed and medication to fish, check raceways and ponds for signs of fish disease and stress, prepare fish for distribution and transport fish, maintain reports and records as required, assist in production related activities, assist in giving tours to visitors, responsible for maintenance of buildings, and upkeep of treatment systems, grounds, and hatchery equipment. Perform other duties as assigned.

REQUIRED EXPERIENCE, TRAINING & ELIGIBILITY:

Graduation from high school or equivalent certification of formal training.
